We at CT Engineering GmbH are pleased to welcome you to our homepage. The protection of your privacy when using our websites is of particular concern to us. Therefore, we would like to inform you about the collection of anonymous and personal data. This website is an online offer of CT Engineering GmbH on the Internet. This web address and any subdomains provide comprehensive information and online services on our company's products and services.

### Contents of the online offer

The author reserves the right not to be responsible for the topicality, correctness, completeness or quality of the information provided. Liability claims against the author relating to material or non-material damage caused by the use or non-use of the information provided or by the use of incorrect or incomplete information are generally excluded, unless there is evidence of wilful intent or gross negligence on the part of the author. All offers are subject to change and non-binding. The author expressly reserves the right to change, supplement or delete parts of the pages or the entire offer without separate announcement or to cease publication temporarily or permanently.

### Anonymous data collection

You can visit our website anonymously, i.e. without telling us who you are. However, as is usual for almost all websites, the server on which our website is located automatically collects information from you when you visit our site (hereinafter referred to as "web server protocols"). The web server automatically logs certain information such as your IP address, the date and time of your visit, the sub-pages you visited, pages you visited previously, the browser you used, the operating system you used or the domain name and the address of your Internet provider.

### Collection and processing of personal data

CT Engineering GmbH only collects data from you (except within the scope of the web server protocols) if you provide it to us yourself in order to use one of our offered services (e.g. ordering information material, inquiries, product-related processes, partner programs). This data is processed and/or used exclusively for the execution of the respective service within CT Engineering GmbH.

Your personal data will not be transmitted to any other third parties.

### Google Analytics

The CT Engineering GmbH website uses Google Analytics, a web analysis service of Google Inc. ("Google"). Google Analytics uses "cookies", which are text files saved on your computer, to help the website analyse how you use the site. The information generated by the cookie about your use of this website is usually transferred to a Google server in the USA and stored there. However, if IP anonymisation is activated on this website, Google will reduce your IP address within Member States of the European Union or in other states party to the Agreement on the European Economic Area beforehand. Only in exceptional cases will the full IP address be transmitted to a Google server in the USA and shortened there.
